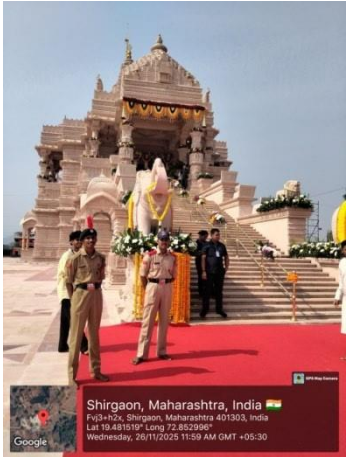
Sagari Kawach Abhiyan
