

> Later, the trustee of the institution, Retired col. Maj. Manohar Karpe discussed the various problems faced by the institution and situations the inmates have to face. Students interacted with him on more topics.

Overall, the visit was insightful. 13 students from TYBA and 11 students from SYBA attended this visit. Cognitive development and developmental disorders being part of their syllabus, they learned how what they study is practically applied.




introduction of the Resource person. Mr.Manish Shesha gave a brief introduction about the various opportunities and scope in the field of Artificial Intelligence and Data Science.

test, it sets them apart from the crowd and they acquire a lifelong tag from Microsoft. He continued about the Microsoft







Chrysanthemum along with the fillers such as Elephant grass, Fan palm, Umbrella Palm Solidago.








3. **Western Style (Circular Shape):** The fundamental concept about this arrangement is that this design looks the same from all the directions. The pretty flowers such as white rose, peach rose, Chrysanthemum (Pink & White) and some fillers were added like Baby's breath and umbrella palm.







- 4. **Western Style (Crescent Shape):** This type of arrangement is also known as half moon type of flower arrangement. The flowers used in this Jumelia (type of rose) and gladiolus with some filler are Eureka plant, Baby's breath and English Fern.
- 5. **Free Style:** This type of flower arrangement is usually seen in the lobby area. With the use of elegant flowers and fillers this beautiful arrangement was done. The names of the flowers are Springeri, heliconia, torch ginger, sweet Williams and Chrysanthemum with the fusion of some filler which is reed, leather fern, dracaena leaves and umbrella palm. Below are a few more glimpses of the workshop.

Overall, it was an informative and survival skills workshop to deal efficiently with emergency situations.
















