



Brief report of programme (in 250 -300 words)

The Department of Psychology along with the Department of English had organized an educational visit to NIRDHAR PRATISHTHAN: a residential institution for individuals with mental retardation, Kaner, Virar (West) on 22nd July, 2022 from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. The institution holds residential facilities for 38 male and 7 female inmates with mental retardation. These inmates have been taken care of by the caretaker Mr. Datta Dalvi and 11 other helping staff. The students interacted with the inmates. The inmates staged a performance for the students like singing songs. The students also entertained them with storytelling and songs.

Later, the trustee of the institution, Retired col. Maj. Manohar Karpe discussed the various problems faced by the institution and situations the inmates have to face. Students interacted with him on more topics.

Overall, the visit was insightful. 13 students from TYBA and 11 students from SYBA attended this visit. Cognitive development

The industrial visit for SYBMM and TYBMM, Department of Mass Media was taken to Delhi, Chandigarh and Amritsar from 1st February 2019 to 9th February 2019. 58 students accompanied by 3 faculties and 2 tour operators from Balaji Tours were on this IV.

The IV was conducted as per the itinerary except for visit to Red Fort. The proposed visit was cancelled as the Red Fort was closed for visitors due to governmental reasons. All other days went exactly as per the itinerary.

The Industrial Visit was taken to AIR Akashvani, Delhi. Students were divided into 2 batches to make their experience as personal as it can be. 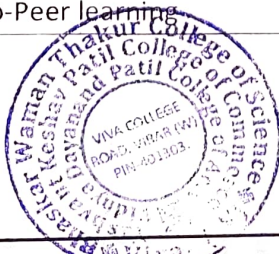
